

## Guidelines for DECEMBER Term End Examination (TEE) 2020 through online mode for Special & Intermediate Semester Student of Master Degree, Bachelor Degree, Post Graduate Diploma, Advance Diploma, Diploma and Certificate Programme

- Special and Intermediate Semester Term End Examination December 2020 of Master degree, Bachelor degree, Post Graduate Diploma, Advance Diploma, Diploma & Certificate programmes will commence from 10th December 2020.
- Learners will also get the opportunity to appear the back papers/left over courses.
- The final date sheet will be available on the university website by 05.12.2020.
- The online student portal for registration will remain active till 03.12.2020
- No registration is allowed after the due date.
- No examination fee shall be charged this time.
- The examination will be conducted purely online and follow MCQ pattern.
- The learners of Master degree & Bachelor degree have to answer 50 multiple choice questions and learners of Post Graduate Diploma, Advance Diploma, Diploma and Certificate Programme have to answer 40 multiple choice questions (all compulsory and will carry equal mark/weightage).
- The duration of examination will be 1 hour (maximum).
- There will be no negative marks for wrong answer or response.
- Learners must submit their response within the prescribed time.
- A learner can submit his/her response only once in each course. However, the learners can review and modify their response before the final submission.
- Learners cannot demand for review or modification after submission.
- The learners have to use their registered email address and the login credentials of the web portal to get the online examination Portal details (Link, uid and password).
- The university will organize a demo or mock test to make the learners familiar with the platform and check the compatibility of their devices. It will be compulsory for all the registered candidates.
- Examination Hall Ticket can be downloaded from university website just after the form fill up.
- University has decided to follow the Computer Monitored Assessment (CMA) instead of Tutor Monitored Assessment (TMA). A separate guideline for Assignment submission and evaluation will be published soon.

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
