



# IIMC Training Programme details

1. Indian Institute of Mass Communication (IIMC) is a Central Government Institute for Journalism and Mass Communication. It provides varieties of courses relating to Mass Comm.
2. IIMC, Eastern Regional Branch is situated at Dhenkanal in Odisha.
3. Odisha State Open University is sending its JMC learners since last three years for hands on training at IIMC, Dhenkanal.
4. The training programme will be fully residential for five days, i.e starting from Monday to Friday evening.
5. Separate hostels will be provided to boys and girls on twin sharing basis.
6. Fooding (which includes tea, breakfast, lunch and dinner) will be provided at the IIMC Canteen.
7. During the training programme more emphasis will be given on hands on training.
8. Learners will prepare TV bulletin, Radio Bulletin which will be aired and publish daily pull outs.
9. Theory classes (minimal) will be added to it.
10. Experts from across the Odisha will be roped in to train the learners.
11. Learners have to deposit a fee of Rs. 2500 for the entire programme.
12. IIMC will provide certificates to the learners at the end of the training.
13. Dhenkanal is well connected by train and bus services from different parts of Odisha.
14. Learners are advised to reach a day prior to the training and accordingly arrangements will be made for their stay.
15. Previous batch learners have immensely benefited from the training and have given excellent feedback on the entire programme.
16. Training will be in batches and 30 nos. of learners will undergo training in one batch.
17. Batch wise training details will be shared with the learners well in advance.
18. OSOU is the only University/Organization in the state to make such a arrangement for its learners with IIMC.
