New pattern of question paper and distribution of marks for Term End Examination of all Post Graduate programmes (from October-2024 admission batch and onwards).

1. The full marks for the TEE question will be 75, which shall be distributed in four Groups as follows:

### Group-A $(3 \times 5 = 15)$ :

There shall be 7 short questions out of which the examinee has to attempt 5 questions (Needs to be answered within 1 page each). Each question carries 3 marks and total marks for the Group-A will be 15. Questions for the Group-A are the level 2 and 3 of the Bloom Taxonomy (Quick Reaction to the subject).

#### Group-B (5 x 5= 25):

There shall be 7 moderately short questions out of which the examinee has to attempt 5 questions (Needs to be answered within 2 pages each). Each question carries 5 marks and total marks for the Group-B will be 25. Questions for the Group-B are the level 2 and 4 of the Bloom Taxonomy (Cognitive Focused).

# Group-C $(10 \times 2 = 20)$ :

There shall be 3 long questions out of which the examinee has to attempt 2 questions (Needs to be answered within 3 pages each). Each question carries 10 marks and total marks for the Group-C will be 20. Questions for the Group-C should be the level 3 of the Bloom Taxonomy (Application Focused).

## Group-D $(15 \times 1 = 15)$ :

There shall be 2 long essay Questions out of which the examinee has to attempt 1 question (Needs to be answered within 4 pages). The question carries 15 marks and total marks for the Group-D will be 15. Questions for the Group-D should be the level 4 of the Bloom Taxonomy (Analysis Focused).

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
